## Conditional / would

### Form:

#### Present:

I would go = I'd go  
I wouldn't go

#### Past:

I would have gone.  
I wouldn't have gone.

### Use:

Probability: I would go, but now I am not sure.

I could go, but I don't (go).

Politeness: Would you like to help me?

Could you do me a favour?

### If-clauses:

1. future:

→ If I win a million, I will buy a new flat.

2. probability / possibility:

→ If I won a million, I would buy a new flat.

3. probability / possibility (past):

→ If I had won a million, I would have bought a new flat.

**!!!NO WOULD IN AN IF-CLAUSE!!!**
